NOTICE OF APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

On October 18, 2012, Industry Telephone Company (Industry) and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC and its Commercial Mobile Radio Service operating affiliates d/b/a AT&T Mobility (collectively, AT&T Mobility) (collectively, Applicants) filed a joint application for approval of an amendment to an existing interconnection agreement (Agreement). The amendment adds provisions for bill-and-keep. The joint application included a copy of the Agreement.

The Agreement meets the requirements of P.U.C. PROC. R. 21.101; therefore, this joint application is approved effective the date this Order is signed.

Applicants shall file two complete interconnection agreements, one unbound, within 15 working days of the date this Order is signed, if not previously filed. The copies shall be clearly marked with the control number assigned to the proceeding and the language "Complete interconnection agreement as approved [or modified and approved] on [insert date]." Also, within 15 working days of the approval of the agreement, the incumbent local exchange company (ILEC) shall post notice of the approved interconnection agreement on its website in a separate, easily identifiable area of the website. The ILEC website shall provide a complete list of approved interconnection agreements, listed alphabetically by carrier, including docket numbers and effective dates. In addition, the ILEC website shall provide a direct link to the Commission's website.
